NARRATIVE

Arrest for Forgery (Counterfeit Money)

The Fairview Police Department Detective Bureau under the direction of Chief John Pinzone and assistance from the United States Secret Service announce the arrest of Krikor Terjanian of 392 Walker Street, Fairview, New Jersey and an adjudicated minor of Fairview, NJ for Forgery, Possession of Forgery Devices, Possession w/intent to distribute CDS within 1000ft of a school zone, Possession w/intent to distribute CDS and Possession w/intent to distribute drug paraphernalia.

On January 4, 2010, at approximately 12:19am, officers from the Fairview Police were called to a report of a fight in the area of 5th Street and Walker Street. Upon arrival officers were confronted by several individuals who were yelling in the street and appeared to have been injured.

Through further investigation it was discovered that the fight was a result of a drug sale gone awry. The investigation resulted in an application for a search warrant of residence where more narcotics and counterfeit money was discovered.

All complaints were forwarded to the Superior Court of New Jersey, Bergen County for disposition. Bail was set by JMC Frank Tortora at \$25,000. Terjanian was subsequently released on bail pending court. A first appearance court date was set for January 6, 2010 for Krikor Terjanian.

Juvenile complaints were forwarded to The Superior Court of New Jersey, Chancery Division, Family Part, Bergen County.

***All defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty in the court of law.**
